(tiresome parking. Not that we'd need any except a drop off, but...)

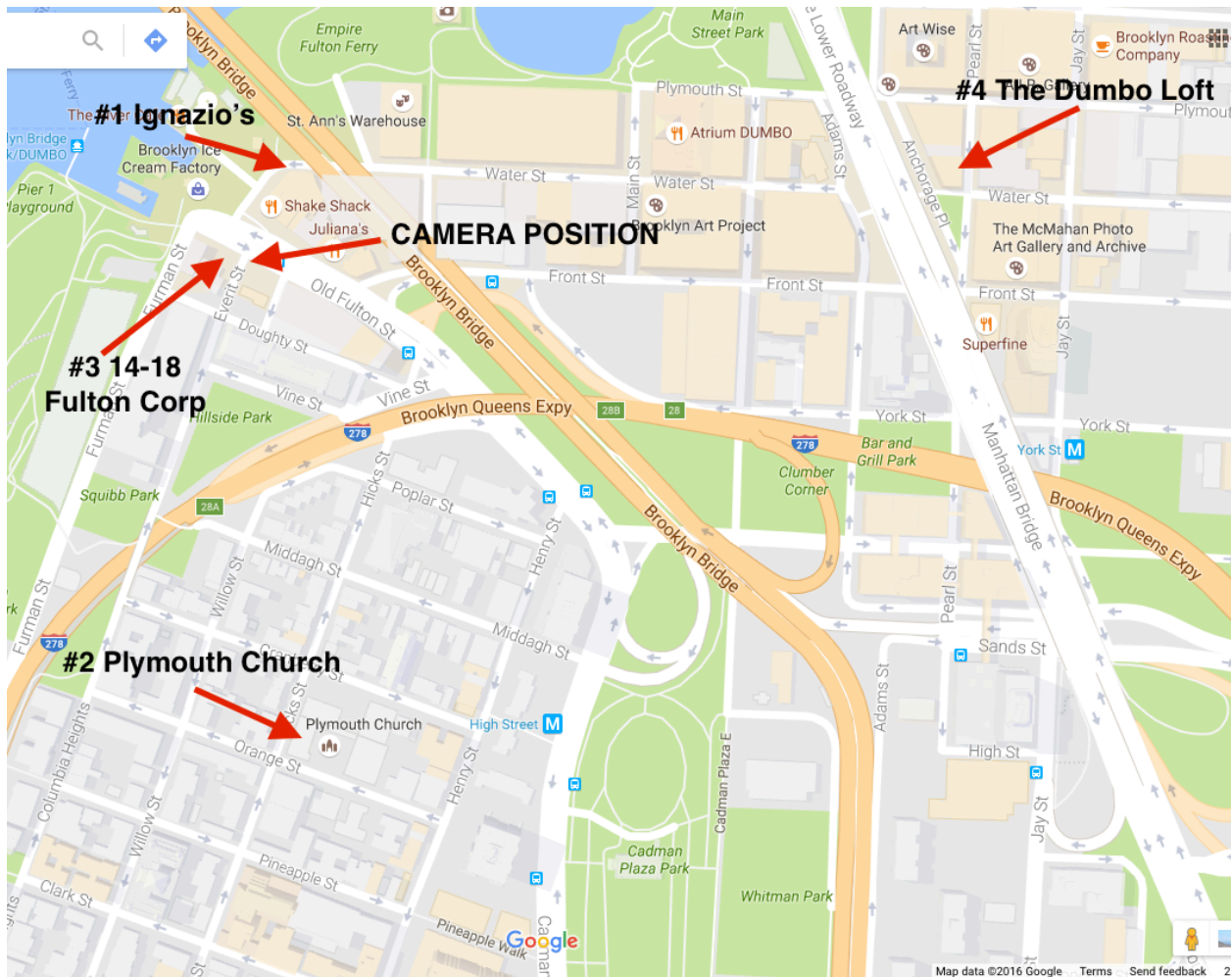
\$2000 for 5AM to 5PM
